The Norfolk County Sheriff, in conjunction with the Fallon Ambulance Service has developed the “Are You OK?” program. It is a FREE daily telephone program that checks on the well-being of senior citizens or people with disabilities. The daily call, between 6 a.m. to 12 noon every day, will ask, “Are You OK?” to allow comfort and security needed to maintain personal independence and give you peace of mind. If there is no answer, a second call will be 5 minutes later. If still no answer, a designated family member or friend will be contacted and the local safety officials will check on you.

If you are not available on a specific day(s) to receive the phone call, simply call the “Are You OK?” hotline at 1-866-900-7865 and the program will not to make the call on the requested day(s).
