- I. Nurse's Report: The monthly report of the Public Health Nurse was reviewed.
- **II. Public Health Nurse:** Board welcomed Michelle Hockman as the new Millis Public Health Nurse. She started March 11, 2019.
- **III. 8:45 PM** On a motion made by Member Hilton, seconded by Member Lannon and voted unanimously the February 11, 2019 Board of Health meeting minutes were approved with some punctuation changes.
- IV. Stoney Brook Stoney Brook is appearing before the Board of Health at the next meeting on April 8, 2019. The chairman asked that the Director contact Town Council concerning the updated information promised in Stoney Brook's letter dated 11/30/2018.

Discussion: **7:10 PM Discussion – Glen Ellen update** – Jim McKay, DPW Director and planning board member and Melissa Recos, Board of Health & Planning Board Consulting Engineer updated the board on the progress of The Regency at Glenn Ellen project on Orchard street. Over the winter the Board of Selectman discussed issues with erosion controls on Orchard Street related to the project which included, flooding on the road related to the site. Melissa reported that recently she had requested that the projects erosion control on Orchard Street needed to be refreshed and replaced where needed. Jim McKay reported that work on the sewer line to the project is ongoing and that the DPW has a consultant engineer on site watching this portion of the project. It was also reported that the consultant for the Town of Millis Conservation Commission has said it will issue a cease and desist order on the project if any more sediment is seen entering the wetlands. Discussion ensued concerning general responsibilities of the town's consultants for each of the Boards for this project.

Scheduled Public Hearing: 7:30 PM – At 7:40 PM on a motion made by Member Lannon seconded by Member Hilton and unanimously approved the Public Hearing for Micro-Blading

amendments to the Board of Health rules and regulations for Body Art Establishments and practitioners was opened and then closed until the next Board of Health meeting on May 20, 2019 at 8:00 PM (There were no attendees for the Micro Blading hearing).

Discussion: 7:46 PM – Potential single use plastic bag regulation for the town of Millis – Geri Sprague a longtime Millis resident presented information concerning potential single use plastic bag regulations. Medfield will be considering such a regulation at their spring 2019 Town Meeting. Geri has set up an informational showing of the documentary "Bag It" on Wednesday April 17, 2019 to begin to educate the public on this issue and is working on developing a similar regulation for the Town of Millis potentially for the fall 2019 Town Meeting.

On a motion made by Member Lannon and seconded by Member Hilton and unanimously approved, the March 25, 2019 Board of Health meeting was closed at 9:45 PM.
