Ms. Barry presented the funding request application for the first phase of preserving the Henry F. Walling Map. Ms. Barry provided a history of the map and stated that the Millis Public Library was gifted the 1852 map earlier in the year by Ms. Nancy Gittins. According to Ms. Barry, the Trustees would like to have the map stabilized and minimally repaired as part of that stabilization. The anticipated Phase II of the project would lead to the display of the map in the Local History room of the library (shadow box; framing; plaque, etc.). The Committee reviewed the information provided.

Ms. Barry stated that they are currently requesting \$600.00 from Historic Resources Reserve CPA funds to preserve and rehabilitate the rare map — "a historic town document."

On a motion made by Mr. Baker, seconded by Mr. McKay, it was unanimously voted (7-0) in favor of appropriating **\$600.00** from the **Historic Resources Reserve** for Phase I restoration of the Henry F. Walling Map Preservation Project.

The Community Preservation Committee recommends approval for an article to be placed on the warrant for the spring town meeting in May 2020.
