The grassy fields across from the Oak Grove Farm houses approximately 40 acres of town-owned open fields, abutting Bogastow Brook. Two of the fields are dedicated conservation land, known as the Dewey and Cassidy Farms. These properties are good locations for bird watching and feature picturesque views of the brook. This hidden gem offers visitors the chance to catch views of the waterfowl and herons that call Bogastow home.
