Foundations Starting

The site work has progressed around the footprint of the building and, excavation for the foundations started. The foundation for the first wing of the new school building began last week. Other wings will be done in succession.



Trucks will be delivering steel and rebar this week. Footings will be poured. Forms and rebar for the foundations will start this week as well. Pictures show rebar and forms delivery and excavation for the foundation start.

These are major milestones in the progression and schedule of the work. We remain on schedule and are making the best use of the winter conditions.

Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP)

If approved, it will be presented to the Board of Selectmen on Monday, February 26th for their approval.

An arborist has been to the site to work on the oak and pine trees that are in protected areas. Pruning of the trees was done and cables were installed to protect the branches of the oak tree. Once the ground has thawed, the arborist will return in the spring to do deep root fertilizing.
