There Is A Lot Of Progress to Show

Work continues inside the building, doing final cleaning and installing technology throughout the building. The building mechanical systems, which are all operational, are being balanced. We expect the climbing wall in the gym to be installed starting next week.

Work outside continues in many areas now that the weather has improved. The sign is going up on the building, landscaping is being installed and the bench seating for the exterior classrooms is approaching completion. Temporary roadwork is in progress and the construction fence is scheduled to be moved in a few weeks. Preparations are well underway to move the construction trailers to an area behind the current Clyde Brown School.

This is a particularly busy time for the construction team, wrapping up construction inside the new building and preparing punch lists for final acceptance, while preparing for the movement of staff from the existing school in June and the delivery of furniture. It is possible that the Elementary School Building Committee may elect to delay the Certificate of Occupancy until mid-June to allow more time to complete the building prior to final acceptance. This delay will not affect the schedule and will still allow the teachers to relocate to the new building immediately following the end of school on June 14th. Demolition of the old building, new traffic patterns and parking improvements have been planned and will begin in earnest as soon as the school year ends on June 14.

Planning for the ribbon cutting and dedication of the new school continues. Mark your calendars for September 7th!




















