School Building Progress

Progress on the site is steady and we are still working toward being able to close the building up by November so that winter work can be done. There are new pictures of the exterior masonry work with the new colored exterior walls. That work will be ongoing. The standing seam roof will start next week.

Interior work continues with electrical, plumbing, HVAC, fire protection, waterproofing and utilities. Drywall has been going up for the last month and will continue. On average, there are 60 to 70 people a day working on site. We are now at 41% completion and we expect the Certificate of Completion by the end of school in June, 2019. We are still on schedule and on budget.

Pictures of work progress follow. The blue-colored exterior Air Vapor Barrier is waterproofing in the picture below and will be covered by masonry.
