

Available Food Services During the COVID-19 Crisis

Millis Public Schools' Food Services is dedicated to ensuring all students receive breakfast and lunch during the COVID-19 Shut down. In order to ensure that ALL students' nutritional needs continue to be satisfied during this closure, we are offering all families the opportunity to have continued access to school meals.

- A “grab and go” breakfast and lunch will be available for pick-up, Monday, Wednesday and Friday outside of the Millis Middle/High School main entrance from 7:30-10:30 a.m.
- **Any person 18 or younger** can receive breakfast and lunch for TWO days on Mondays and Wednesdays and for THREE days on Fridays. These meals will include an entree, side of fruit and/or vegetable, and milk. Parents and guardians of any student will be able to pull-up to the Millis Middle/High School front entrance and pick up their meals without having to leave their vehicle.
