**SHERIFF McDERMOTT ADDRESSES MILLIS SELECT BOARD**

Norfolk County Sheriff Jerry P. McDermott recently addressed the Millis Select Board to provide an update on various programs and partnerships involving the Town of Millis. This included the availability of inmate work crews, which have saved taxpayers in Norfolk County over \$250k in 2019. In the Town of Millis, the community service work program has logged over 270 labor hours, which in turn, created a cost savings of \$4,681.80.

During the meeting, town officials voiced their appreciation for the Norfolk County Sheriff's Office Community Service Work Program. "Sheriff McDermott and his team have been incredible with helping our town on many projects," said Loring Barnes Edmonds, Chair of the Select Board. "Having seen the individuals and the work that they have done, I can see this is a great symbiotic

relationship, and I hope the people understand that," said Michael J. Guzinski, Millis Town Administrator.
